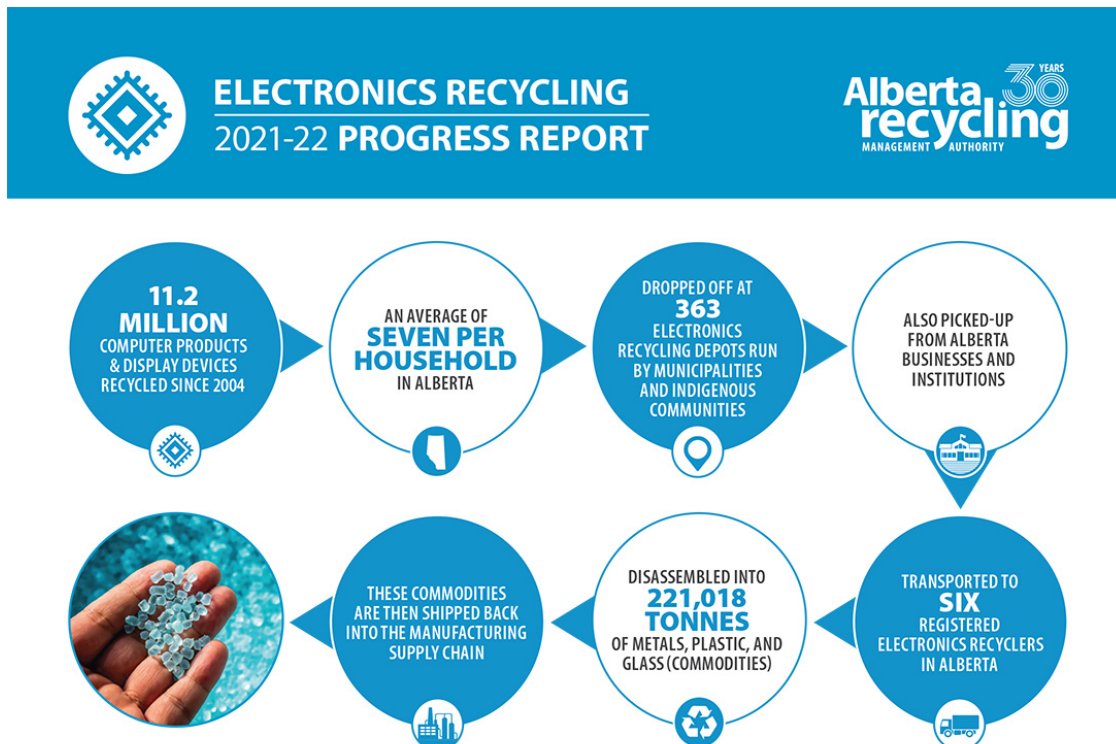

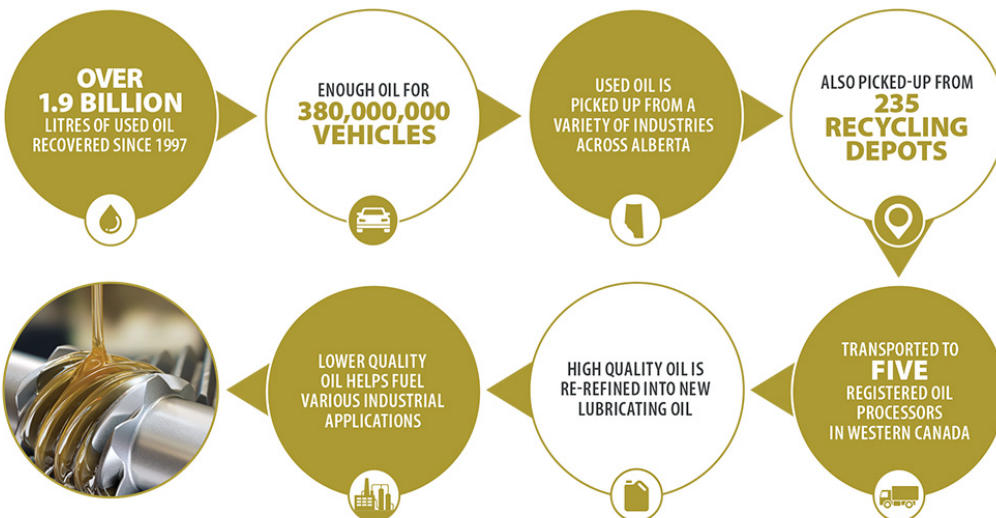
1. 2021-2022 Progress Report Postcards for the Electronics, Paint, Tire, and Used Oil Materials Recycling Programs

These individual 5"x7" cards provide a handy reference at your fingertips that highlight key program information.

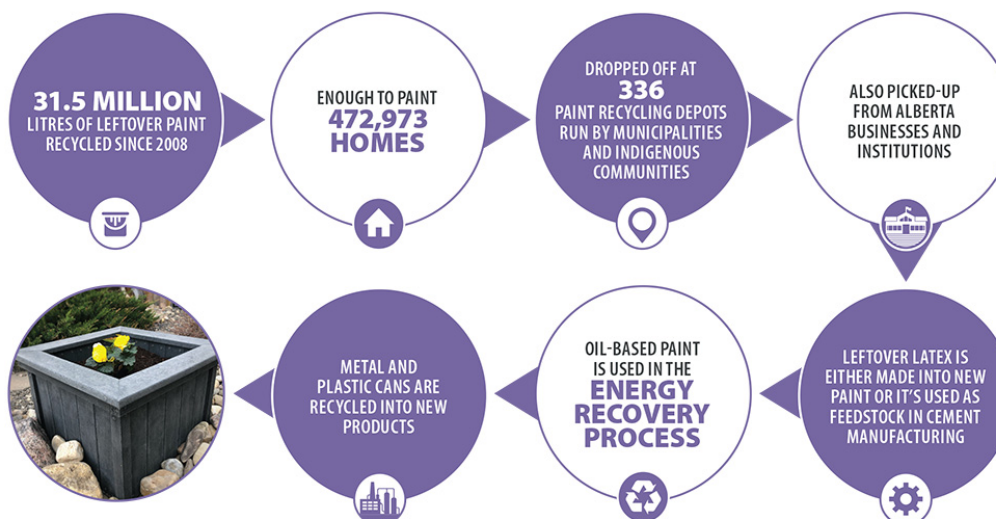




USED OIL & MATERIALS RECYCLING 2021-22 PROGRESS REPORT

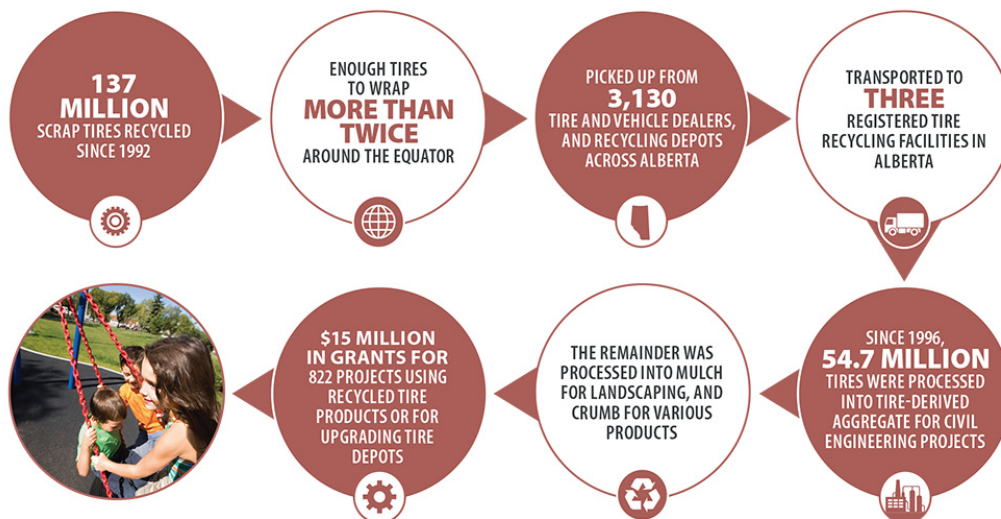


PAINT RECYCLING 2021-22 PROGRESS REPORT
